## **Youth Transition Services**

On My Own's Youth Transition Services are offered to youth with disabilities between the ages of 16-24.

### **Individual Transition Plan (ITP):**

- Provides Education Advocacy
- Builds on existing Individualized Education Plan (IEP)
- Identifies employment, post-secondary education, living well with a disability, life skills trainings
- Assistive Technology Devices are available to help students with disabilities maximize accessibility and learning
- On My Own partners with area schools and can attend IEP meetings

### **Transition Courses:**

- Our Youth Transition Specialist facilitates courses around transitioning youth into adulthood
- Courses can be taught in schools or other public settings
- Course can include: transition and advocacy skills, career and post-secondary readiness and other necessary life's skills trainings

### **Employment Services:**

On My Own partners with Missouri Vocational Rehabilitation to provide job coaching to help students reach their vocational goals.

### **Scholarship program:**

On My Own offers scholarships to students with disabilities or students with a disabled parent.
