5 Core Services:

1. Independent Living Skills Training:

Skills necessary to promote an individuals independent living goals are taught in either a one-on-one or small group setting.

2. Peer Support:

OMO sponsors support groups that allow consumers to share information and draw on the experience of others.

3. Information & Referral:

We provide consumers with a wide variety of information and resources relating to disabilities. Referrals to other appropriate agencies are provided as needed.

Assistance is available in locating; housing, recreational opportunities, interpreters, transportation, etc.

4. Advocacy: Individual and systems

The basis for our work in individual and systems advocacy is based on Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act and the ADA. Advocacy with public policy issues include, housing rights, transportation, Home and Community Bases Services, employment, education, community activities, Olmstead, public services, etc.

5. Transition Team:

Adult- Adults wishing to transfer from nursing home into independent living and their community.

Youth- On My Own can assist youth in developing a transition plan and education them on their rights needed for living independent in their community.

→ **Assistive & Adaptive Equipment**

We offer wheelchairs, portable ramps, bedside commodes, shower chairs, canes, crutches, hospital beds, telephones, magnifiers, talking devices, screen reader devices, large print materials, etc.

A specialist can help a person get back into the workforce without losing their benefits. Counseling involves programs like Ticket to Work, job searching, help finding work incentives, work accommodations, and help guide you through the Social Security process.

→ **ADA Assessments**

This program provides interior modifications for a person in a wheelchair to have independent access to their own home. Our Ramp Program allows a person in a wheelchair to have access entering and exiting their home.
